Dr. Maria Rosario (Cherry) Piquero-Ballescás is a distinguished sociologist and a leading voice on Filipino migration. In recognition of her lifetime commitment to Japan-Philippine relations, she was awarded the Order of the Rising Sun in 2025 and a Foreign Minister's Commendation in 2022. As the author of the seminal work *Filipino Entertainers in Japan*, her research spans gender, development, and the evolving identity of the Filipino diaspora in Japan.

A retired Professor from Toyo University and UP System (Diliman and Cebu), she currently serves as a Professional Lecturer at the UP Cebu College of Creative Arts and Design and a Visiting Researcher at the University of Shizuoka and Research Fellow at the Center for Sustainable Development Studies, Toyo University. She is coordinator of the UNU-accredited Regional Center of Expertise on Education for Sustainable Development (RCE-Cebu) and a columnist for the Cebu newspaper, *The Freeman*.
